

# Visitation Policy

*as of December 7, 2022*

## **The Women's Health and Birth Area**

- We are allowing TWO support persons for our laboring patients during their stay. Support persons **MUST** be over the age of 18 unless that person is the other parent. A doula or community midwife is considered part of the health care team and can visit in addition to the TWO support persons during labor.
- We are also allowing TWO designated support persons or the legal parents or guardians of pediatric patients. Support persons **MUST** be over the age of 18 unless they are a parent of pediatric patients.
- Visitors who are currently ill with fever, respiratory symptoms, cough, rash, or any disease which may be contagious, or who may have been recently exposed to contagious disease will not be permitted on the unit.
- Visitors who are immunocompromised or who have health issues that make them more vulnerable to illness complications strongly consider not visiting or limiting visitation.
- All visitors and staff are required to wear a mask.
